## ***A one-day community course on Workers Rights & Employment Law***

Whether a private employee concerned with Right to Work and the direction of labor and employment law generally, or a Wisconsin public sector employee reeling from Act 10 and concerned that employees simply have no rights, employees need to understand and enforce what rights they still have on the job.

This one-day community course will provide a brief overview of workers' rights under state and federal employment law. We will review the protections workers have and where to go for enforcement of those rights.

### ***Topics to be addressed include:***

- ▶ Workers' continued ability to work towards improving working conditions
- ▶ Laws that protect from discrimination and harassment, including age discrimination, Family Medical Leave Act, potential changes in Wisconsin Wage & Hour regulations
- ▶ Brief introduction to Workers' Compensation
- ▶ Prevailing Wage laws
- ▶ Potential changes coming to WI Health & Safety regulations
- ▶ Workplace protections for veterans
- ▶ Continued right to Union representation and concerted activity
